The following items must be included:

- 1. TITLE
- 2. QUESTION TO BE DEVELOPED OR OBJECTIVE TO BE ATTAINED, consistent with the title and the argument.
- 3. THE SUB-THEME OF THE RENDEZVOUS PERTINENT TO THE PROPOSED PAPER (this is important). The sub-themes appear in an attached document.
- 4. ARGUMENT OF THE PAPER: a text of 1,500 to 2,500 characters including spaces, so that the Scientific Committee and its reviewers may understand the interest of the proposal and its consonance with the modality of work of the Rendezvous, current relevance and pertinence regarding the theme.
- 5. CONCORDANCE OF THE FINAL VERSION OF THE PAPER WITH THE REQUIREMENTS THAT APPEAR BELOW.

FORMAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE FINAL VERSION OF PAPERS

The deadline for sending the selected proposals: 10 May 2020.

- 1. TITLE
- 2. SUMMARY OF UP TO 800 CHARACTERS INCLUDING SPACES

3. KEY WORDS (THREE TO FIVE)

- 4. TEXT of up to **6,500 characters including spaces**, as a **formal condition for the acceptance of the paper**. If this limit is exceeded, the paper will be returned to the author, as the purpose of the Rendezvous is to facilitate the debate, rather than long presentations.
- 5. BIBLIOGRAPHICAL REFERENCES: these are not included in the limit of 6,500 characters and should include all the authors of quotations, in order to facilitate the work of the interpreters. We recommend the inclusion, apart from classical references, some of the last few years.
